


PARTS OF THE STRING INSTRUMENTS



Across

- 2. The pointed part of the bow
- 5. A small piece of round wood inside the instrument
- 6. A long narrow piece of wood where your fingers are placed to create notes
- 9. The top part of an instrument that looks like a snail.
- 11. The part of the bow which produces a sound
- 13. A small circular part at the bottom of a violin or viola
- 15. The narrow area between the scroll and the body of the instrument
- 16. A pointed adjustable part on cellos and basses
- 17. The small rectangular part of a bow that sometimes has an "eye"

Down

- 1. The ridge at the top of the fingerboard
- 3. These are turned to tune the strings
- 4. A part where sound waves can enter to be amplified
- 6. A small metal part on the bow frog
- 7. A part used to attach the strings to the bottom of the instrument
- 8. A thin piece of wood which holds the strings up
- 10. A place to rest your "chin" on the violin or viola
- 12. Four parts that are plucked or bowed to create sound
- 14. Long skinny wooden part of the bow
