Christmas is right around the corner! It's a perfect time to do good things, for example, donating some money to the charity. We have recorded the amount of the money

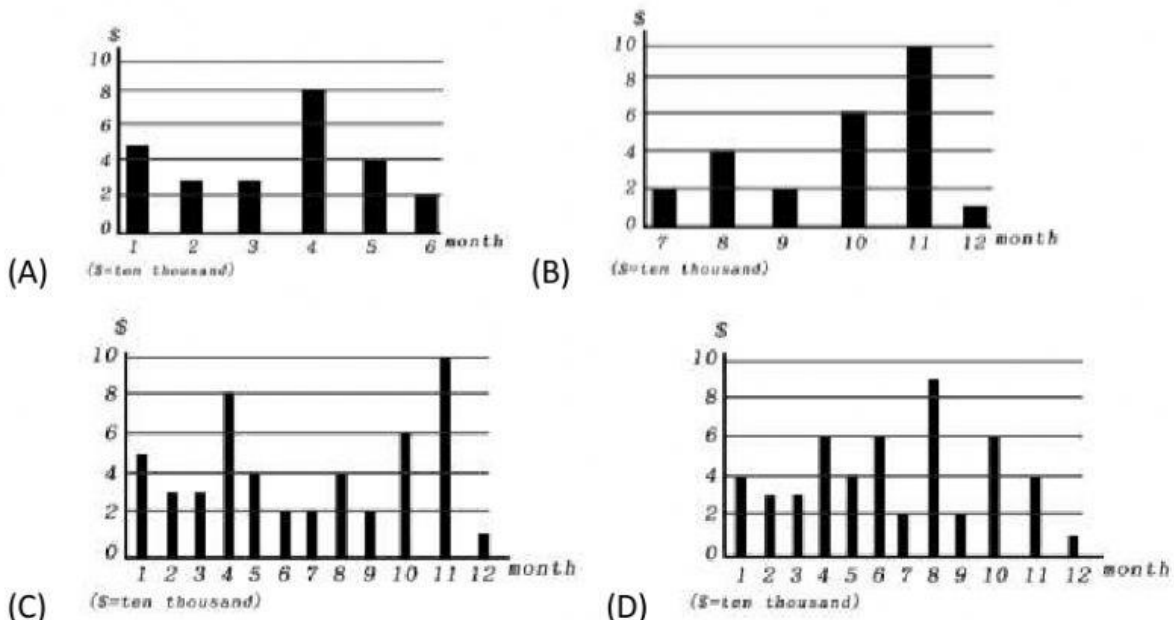
donated to the charities in Incredible City this year.
