## Let's learn the Present Simple!

Here are some rules!

To form the (+) Affirmative Form ↓

Subject + Verb + Complement

I play with my cousin.

*(Yo juego con mi primo.)*

Subject + Verb + S + Complement

He **eats** breakfast at home.

*(Él toma el desayuno en casa.)*

To form the (-) Negative Form ↓

Subject + Do / Does + Not + Infinitive + Complement

I **don't** play with my cousin.

He **doesn't eat** breakfast at home.

To form the (?) Interrogative Form ↓

Do / Does + Subject + Infinitive + Complement...?

**Do** you play with your cousin?  
**Does** he **eat** breakfast at home?
