	A device that cools and dehumidifies the air in a room or building.	G) Smartphone
	A device used for cleaning floors, carpets, and other surfaces by suctioning up dirt and dust.	H) Refrigerator

	A four-wheeled vehicle powered by an engine, used for transportation on roads.	A) Car
	A two-wheeled vehicle powered by pedals, used for transportation or recreation.	B) Airplane
	A series of connected rail cars or carriages that transport passengers or cargo on tracks.	C) Train
	A large vehicle used for public transportation, typically on a fixed route with multiple stops.	D) Bus
	A watercraft used for transportation or leisure activities on water.	E) Bicycle
	A powered flying vehicle used for transportation or aerial activities.	F) Scooter
	A two-wheeled vehicle powered by an engine, used for transportation or recreation.	G) Motorcycle
	A two-wheeled vehicle with a step-through frame and small wheels, used for transportation or leisure activities.	H) Boat

	A detached residential dwelling designed for occupancy by a single family or household.	A) Condominium
	A multi-unit residential building with individual living units rented out to tenants.	B) Bungalow
	A multi-level residential building that shares one or more walls with neighboring units.	C) Single-family house
	A two-unit residential building, often with one unit on the ground floor and another on the upper floor.	D) Mobile home
	A multi-unit residential building where individual units are owned by their occupants, but the common areas are shared.	E) Cottage
	A prefabricated dwelling designed for transportation on public roads.	F) Duplex
	A small, single-story house with a low-pitched roof and wide front porch.	G) Townhouse
	A small, cozy house, often with a thatched roof, typically used as a vacation or seasonal residence.	H) Apartment
