1. Etymology

- **Education** > learning & **Education** = (1) + (2) of a person
- Latin root:
 - proximately, **Education** ← *educare* (to bring up)
 - distantly, **Education** ← *educere* (to bring forth) – (*e*: out + *ducere*: to lead)

→ What education means?

- education > (3) (1 word)
- education = to draw out the (4) of young people to hone their (5) and (6)

2. Modern usage:

- Education > (9)
