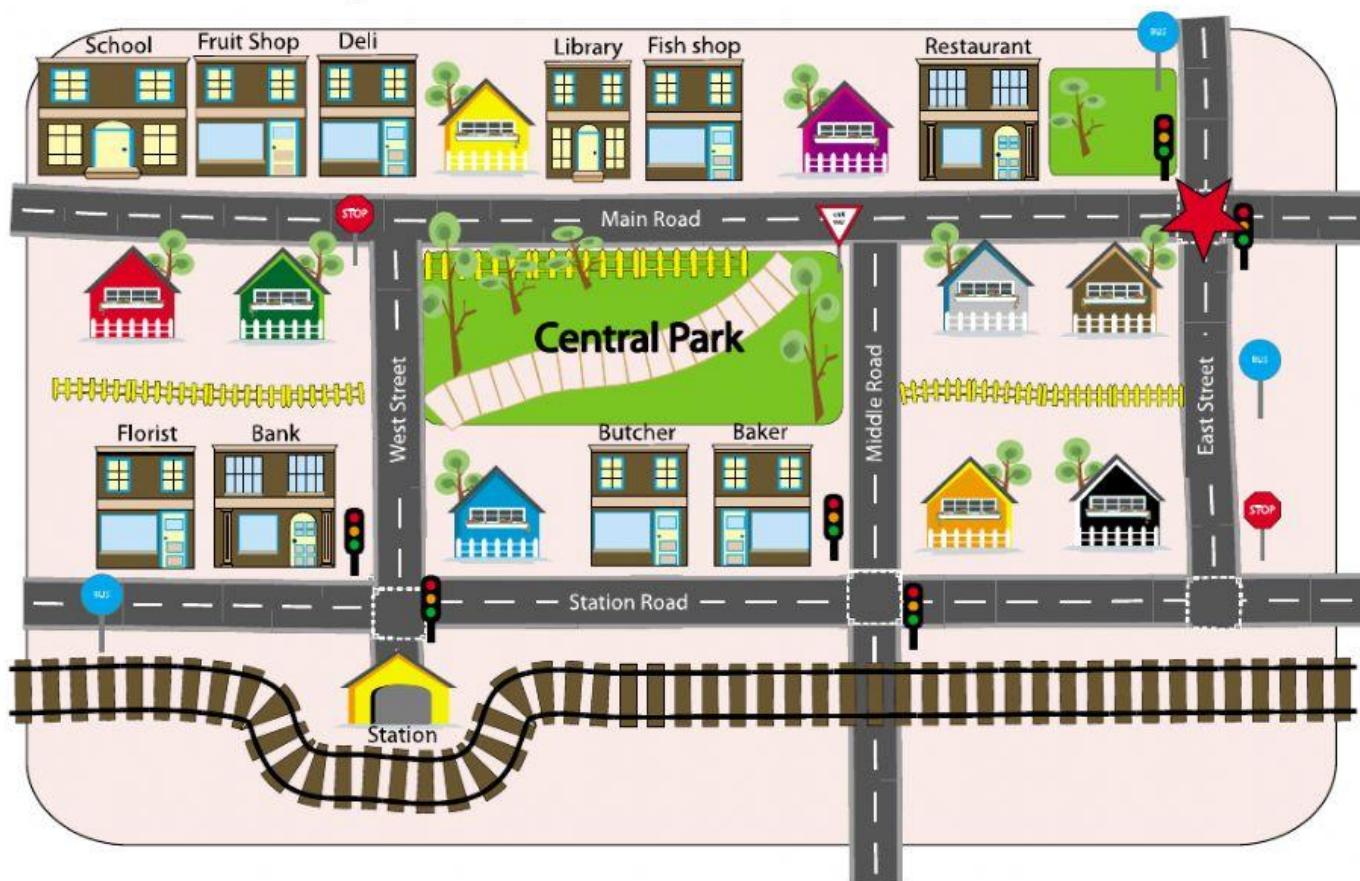

On the ground floor there is the hall, the kitchen, a pantry, the living room, a big dining room and a toilet.

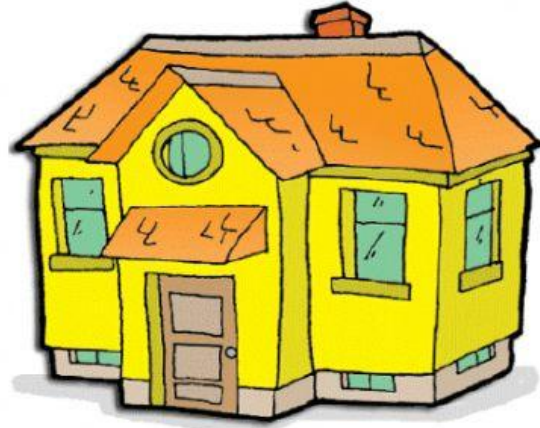
