pound of cure**

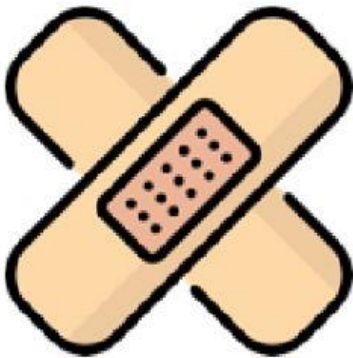
Something that looks good on

after it has happened

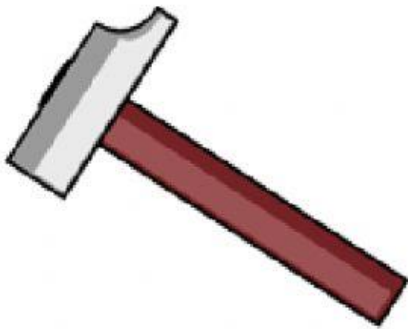
