What do we have ...? and When do we have ...? are **Wh-** questions.

We use **when** to ask about the time something happens. We use **what** to ask for other information.

On is a preposition of time. We use **on** before a day of the week to say when something happens.

We use the plural of the day of the week to say that something happens every week on that day.




