We use the present progressive to talk about:

- Something that is happening at the moment we are speaking.

She's talking to someone on the phone at the moment.

- Something that is happening around now for a short time.

Eric and Tim are staying at their aunt's house for two months.

We do not use short forms after two names. We do not use the present progressive to talk about things that happen regularly.

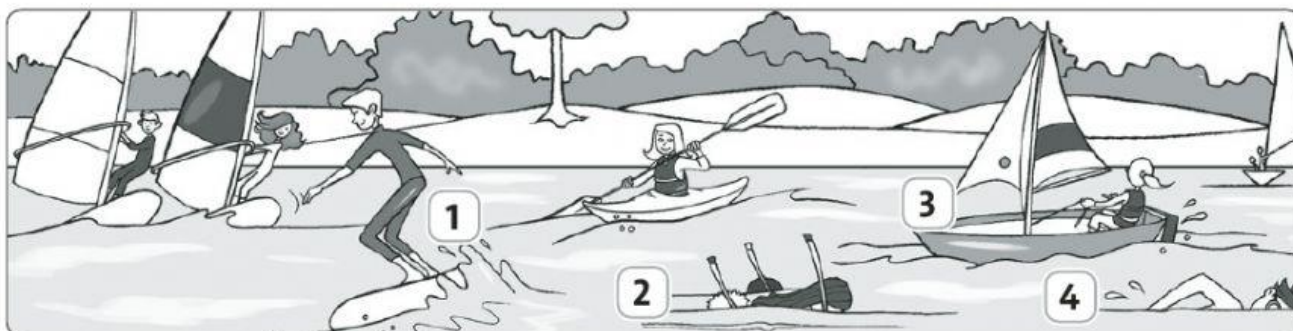

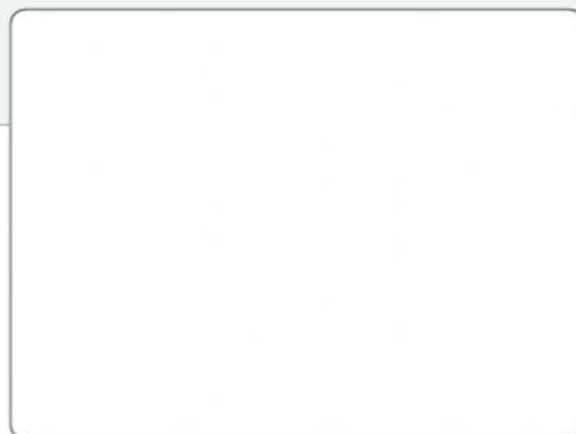

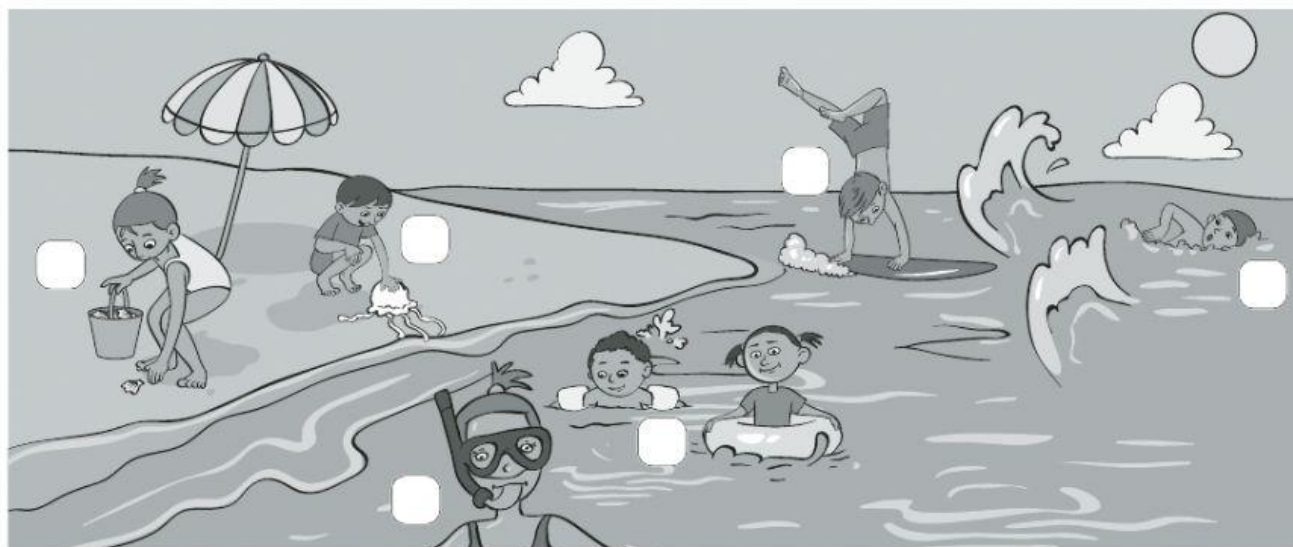
