A 주격대명사와 목적격 대명사 Subject and Object Pronouns

① 주격대명사는 문장의 주어로 쓰이는 명사를 대신하는 말로 '~가'를 뜻한다.

My father is a teacher. **He** teaches history. (He = My father)

② 목적격 대명사는 동사 또는 전치사의 목적어로 쓰이는 명사를 대신하는 말이며, '~를'을 뜻한다.

(동사의 목적어) Do you drink milk? Yes. I drink **it** every day. (it = milk)

(전치사의 목적어) I go to school with Amy. I study with **her**. (her = Amy)

B 명사의 소유격 Possessive Nouns

① 명사의 소유격은 명사의 끝에 <'s>를 붙이나, 명사가 <s>로 끝나는 경우에는 <'>만 붙이기도 한다.

단수	monkey	☞ monkey's	man	☞ man's	Charles	☞ Charles' or Charles's
복수	monkeys	☞ monkeys'	men	☞ men's	Charles and Mary	☞ Charles and Mary's

② 명사의 소유격은 '~의' 또는 '~의 것'을 뜻한다.

That **monkey's** tail is long. **Charles'** computer is new.

Those **monkeys'** tails are long. This is **Charles and Mary's** science project.

C 소유격 Possessive Adjectives과 소유대명사 Possessive Pronouns

① 소유격에는 <my, our, your, his, her, its, their>가 있다.

② 소유격은 명사의 앞에 쓰이며, '~의'를 뜻한다.

That is **our** school. These are **their** umbrellas.

③ 소유대명사에는 <mine, ours, yours, his, hers, theirs>가 있다.

④ 소유대명사는 '~의 것'을 뜻한다. 소유대명사는 <소유격 + 명사> 대신 쓸 수 있다.

This is her tent. ☞ This is **hers**. This is your camera. ☞ This is **yours**.
