

(Nouns/Pronouns)

The word better is already a comparative degree, so we shouldn't add "more" with it. 2-With comparative degree of adjective we use “ than ” (after than we use subject pronoun)	My friend is smarter of I am. My friend is smarter I am.
3-In structure like “The higher we go, the cooler it is” we always use comparative degree.	The close we go to the sun, the hot it becomes. The we go to the sun, the it becomes.
4-With superlative degree we use “ of ”.	Burj Khalifa is the tallest building than all in Dubai. Burj Khalifa is the tallest building all in Dubai.
5-“ The ” is usually used with Superlative degree .	He is most intelligent student of all in his class. He is most intelligent student of all in his class.
6-When an adjective refers to the whole class “the” is used before it.	The gap between rich and poor has widened. The gap between rich and poor has widened.
7-With adjectives like “ superior, inferior, junior, senior and prior ” we use “ to ”	a. There are several people junior from me. There are several people junior me. b. The will was made two days prior than his death. The will was made two days prior his death.
