

Mixed Conditionals Practice

First Conditional:

If it rains, I will take an umbrella. / I will take an umbrella if it rains.

Explanation: The first conditional expresses a possible condition in the present or future and its likely result. It is

If + present, will + verb / will + verb + If + present

Second Conditional:

If I had more time, I would go on a vacation. / I would go on vacation if I had more time.

Explanation: The second conditional expresses an unreal or unlikely condition in the *present or future* and its hypothetical/unreal result.

If + past, would + verb / would + verb + If + past

Third Conditional:

If she had studied harder, she would have passed. / She would have passed if she had studied harder.

Explanation: The third conditional expresses an unreal condition in the *past* and its hypothetical/unreal result.

If + had + past participle, would + have + past participle / would + have + past participle + If + had + past participle
