A <Be>동사의 현재시제

- ① <Be>동사의 현재시제는 '~이다'의 뜻을 가지며, (am, are, is)의 세 종류가 있다.
 ② <Be>동사의 부정은 <Be + not>이다. <Yes/No> 의문문은 <Be>동사를 주어 앞에 둔다.

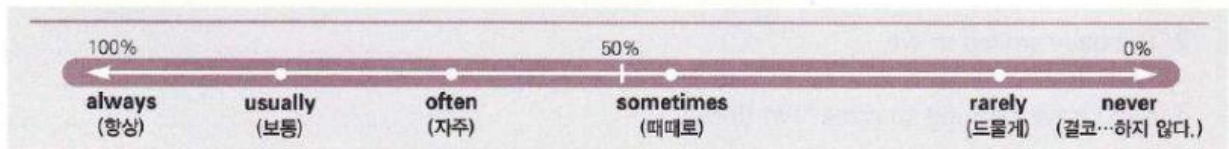
B 일반동사의 현재시제

- ① 일반동사 현재시제의 긍정문에서 주어가 3인칭 단수 (she/he/it)일 경우는 동사의 형태에 따라 동사의 뒤에 <-s/-es>를 붙인다.

• 대부분의 동사	~s	talk → talks	play → plays
• <ch, sh, s, x>로 끝나는 동사	~es	fix → fixes	catch → catches
• <자음 + y>로 끝나는 동사	~ies	fly → flies	try → tries
• 불규칙 동사	•	have → has go → goes do → does	

- ② 현재시제의 부정문에서 주어가 1,2인칭 (I/you) 또는 복수 (we/you/they)일 경우 <don't + 동사원형>을 쓴다.
 주어가 3인칭 단수 (she/he/it)일 경우는 <doesn't + 동사원형>을 쓴다.
 ③ 의문문의 형태는 <Do/Does + 주어 + 동사원형...?>이다.
 긍정은 <Yes, 주어 + do/does.>, 부정은 <No, 주어 + don't/doesn't.>로 대답한다.

C 빈도부사 Frequency Adverb의 용법



- ① 빈도부사는 어떤 행동을 얼마나 자주 하는지를 말하거나 물을 때 사용하는 말이다.
 ② 빈도부사는 주로 일반동사의 앞에 위치한다. I **usually** play basketball after school.
 ③ 빈도부사는 주로 <Be>동사의 뒤에 위치한다. My brother is **never** late for school.
