- A. _____: is a cutting tool with a long handle and a sharp, wedge-shaped metal blade. It is primarily used for chopping wood, splitting logs, and felling trees.
- B. _____: is a heavy-duty construction vehicle equipped with a large blade on the front. It is primarily used for pushing and leveling soil, rocks, and debris during earthmoving and construction projects.
- C. _____: is a short, curved sword with a single-edged blade. Historically used as a weapon, it is now commonly employed for cutting dense vegetation, such as sugarcane or undergrowth.
- D. _____: also known as a combine harvester, is a large machine used in agriculture to harvest crops, such as wheat, corn, or soybeans. It cuts, gathers, threshes, and cleans the crops in a single operation.
- E. _____: is a handheld tool with a long handle and a flat, sharp blade. It is commonly used for cultivating soil, removing weeds, and shaping garden beds.
- F. _____: is a structure used for storing and preserving harvested crops, such as grains or silage. It typically features tall cylindrical silos alongside a barn or storage area.
- G. _____: is a powerful agricultural vehicle used for various tasks on the farm, such as plowing fields, pulling heavy machinery, and transporting goods.
