

PAST SIMPLE AND PAST CONTINUOUS

RULES:

We use the past continuous for an action that we were in the middle of.

They were dancing last evening.



We use the past simple for a complete action in the past.

He ate all his meal.



We often use the past continuous and past simple together when one (shorter) action comes in the middle of another (longer) action.

EXAMPLE:

While we were reading (longer action) on the beach, it started (shorter action) to rain.

He was waiting (longer action) for a train when he heard (shorter action) a voice.

WHILE + PAST CONTINUOUS
