

Lesson 8 Future

1. Grammar Summary

English Korean

미래시제 Future		
	Will	Be Going To
긍정문 Affirmative	We will study tomorrow.	We are going to study tomorrow.
부정문 Negative	We won't study tomorrow.	We aren't going to study tomorrow.
의문문 Question	Will you study tomorrow? Yes, we will ./No, we won't .	Are you going to study tomorrow? Yes, we are ./No, we aren't .

A 미래시제

- ① 미래시제를 나타낼 때는 <will>, <Be going to> 또는 현재진행형을 사용한다.
- ② 미래시제와 함께 쓰는 시간 표현은 다음과 같다.
 - tomorrow, tomorrow morning/afternoon/evening/night (내일, 내일 아침/점심/저녁/밤)
 - next week/weekend/Sunday (다음 주/주말/일요일)
 - next year, next summer/winter (내년, 내년 여름/겨울)

B 미래시제: Will

- ① 긍정문은 <will + 동사원형>이고, 부정문은 <will not + 동사원형>이다.
We/John **will study** tomorrow. We/John **won't study** tomorrow.
- ② <won't>는 <will not>의 준말이다.
- ③ <Yes/No> 의문문은 <Will + 주어 + 동사원형...?>이다.
긍정은 <Yes, 주어 + will.>, 부정은 <No, 주어 + won't.>로 대답한다.
Will they/John come tomorrow? Yes, they/he will. No, they/he won't.
- ④ 대명사와 <will>을 줄여서 <I'll, You'll, He'll, She'll, It'll, We'll, They'll>로 쓰기도 한다.

C 미래시제: Be Going To

- ① 긍정문은 <Be going to + 동사원형>이고, 부정문은 <Be not going to + 동사원형>이다.
주어에 따라 <Be>동사는 <am, are, is>를 사용한다.
We **are going to study** tomorrow. We **are not going to study** tomorrow.
- ② <Yes/No> 의문문을 만들 때는 <Be>동사를 주어의 앞으로 보낸다.
Are you going to study? Yes, I am. No, I'm not.

D 현재진행형을 이용한 미래 표현

- 가까운 미래에 있을 확정된 일이나 계획에 대해서 말할 때는 현재진행형을 사용하기도 한다.
이 때 문장 안에는 미래 시간을 나타내는 표현을 함께 써야 한다.
Sam **is taking** a bus tomorrow morning. (= Sam **is going to take** a bus tomorrow morning.)
