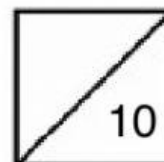

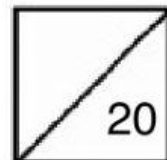

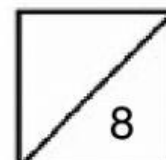
PERSONIFICATION

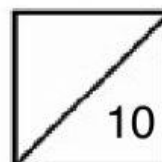
