TAG QUESTIONS

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Tag questions are small questions added to the end of a statement when seeking or expecting confirmation of that statement.

They mean something like: "Am I right?" or "Do you agree?"

They are very common in spoken English rather than the written form.



What are question tags?

Positive question tag

A **positive statement** + **negative question tag**.

- He is a teacher, isn't he?
- She is late, isn't she?
- You'll be ok won't you?
- It's a nice day, isn't it? ✓

Negative question tag

A **negative statement** + **positive question tag**.

- He isn't a teacher, is he?
- She isn't late, is she?
- You won't be ok, will you?
- It isn't a nice day, is it? ✗

- sentence → **+** tag

She isn't American, is she?

You don't study English, do you?

You weren't at home, were you?

Tom wasn't watching TV, was he?

He won't read this book, will he?

He can't read this book, can he?

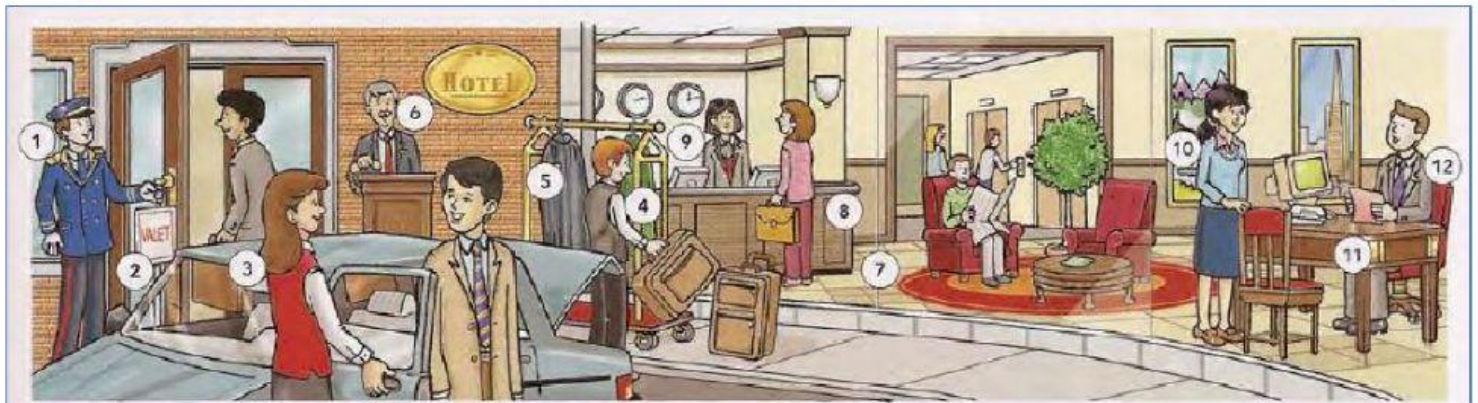
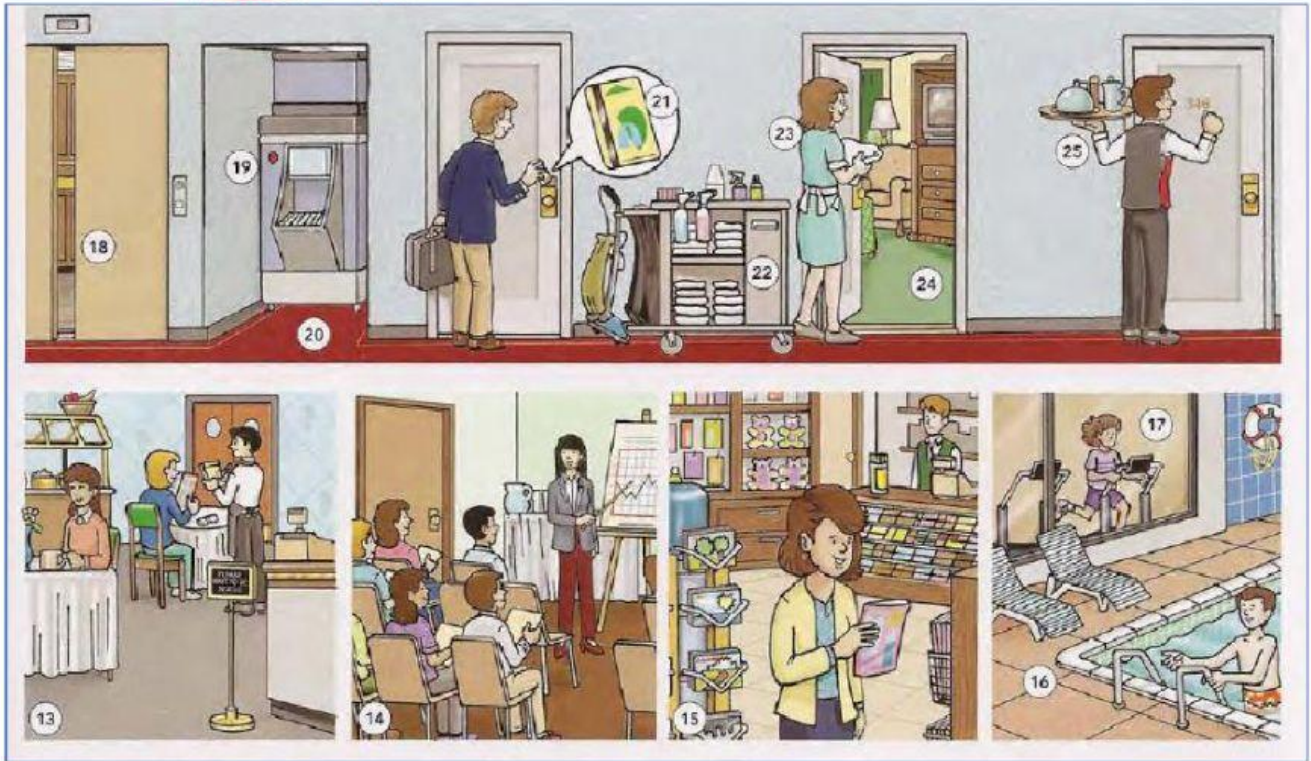
