Ann: Let me make a list of the furniture we still need.

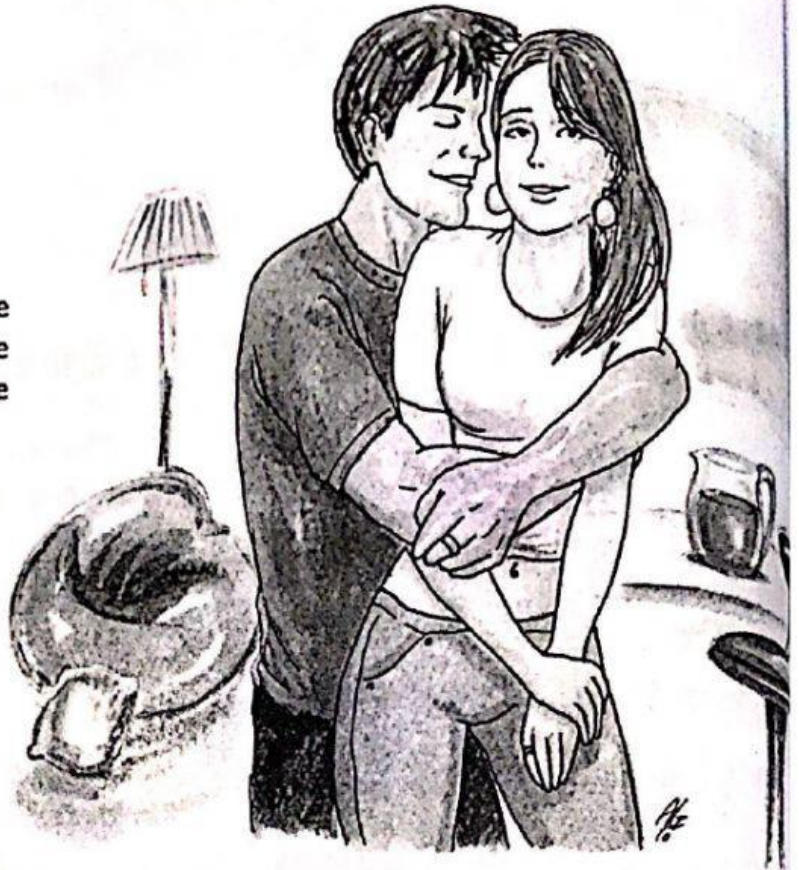
Josh: Ok! The kitchen is big and sunny.
