

HOW TO:

PERFORM BASIC TUNE UP OF AN INJECTION CAR



METHODS / STEPS

MATERIALS & TOOLS

- Gloves
- Engine oil
- Phillips Screwdriver
- Safety jack stand
- Rags or paper towel
- Brake fluid
- Coolant
- Drain pans
- Floor jack

- First, park your vehicle on a flat, dry surface and ensure the engine is cool.
- Second, replace plugs. Clean the engine area of any dirt and debris to prevent anything from falling into the engine cylinder during spark plug replacement. Remove the spark plug wires. Remove the coil on the plug. Unscrew the spark plug. Put in the new spark plugs. Re-install the spark plug wires or ignition coil.
- Third, change the engine air filter. Locate the air filter housing. Open the air filter housing. Remove the old air filter and any debris. Install the new air filter. Match the direction and placement of the old housing. Close the air filter housing and secure it the way it was before.
- Fourth, keep your auxiliary systems in check with new belts. Before removing the belt, you'll need to release the tensioner, which automatically keeps the belt taut while you're driving. Use a ratchet or breaker bar that fits into the bolt and releases the tensioner. Then unrout the belt carefully, taking care not to disturb or damage the network of pulleys and peripherals. After removing the belt, inspect it for signs of damage. Then install the new belt.
- Fifth, check the tires. Check the air in the tires. Add air to the tire as needed. Check your tire tread and wear.
- After checking the tires, check the brakes. Press on the brake pedal and feel the responsiveness of the braking. Check the brake pedal is firmly in place.
- For the last procedure, check the headlights. Park the car with the engine idling and the parking brake engaged. Visually inspect the headlights by looking at the bulbs. Look at the pattern of the headlight beams.
