2. Listen again and complete the sentences.

Canada is the world's (1) largest country with ten provinces and three territories. It is situated in (2) and has a land mass of 9,970,610 square kilometres. Canada **encompasses** (*bao quanh*) six time zones and has the longest (3) of any country. It takes seven hours to fly from Halifax in the east of Canada to Vancouver in the west of Canada. Canada has 38 National Parks and over two million lakes. The largest lake is the Great Bear Lake in the (4) It covers an area of over 31,000 km². Canada is one of the world's **wealthiest** (*giàu có nhất*) nations, due to its wealth of (5); forests, **minerals** (*khoáng sản*) and fossil fuels. Canada has two official languages: English and French. English is used all over Canada except in Quebec, where French is the (6) French is also spoken in some other provinces and territories. Canada is well known for its four **distinct** (*khác biệt*) (7), with **temperatures ranging** (*mức nhiệt*) in central Canada from +30 degrees Celsius in the summer months, to 20 degrees Celsius in the (8) months.
