


A conjunction joins parts of a sentence.



AND: connects same ideas. *She bought apples and bananas for the family.*

BUT: connects opposite ideas. *She's very hard-working but not very imaginative.*

OR: connects different options. *Is it Tuesday or Wednesday today?*

BECAUSE: connects the result of something with its reason. *I can't play because I am tired.*

SO: connects a reason with its result. *My knee started hurting, so I stopped running.*
