



LANDFORMS



1. Join the names of the landforms with their definitions.

A Stream



is a high area of rock or earth with a very steep side. Usually it's next to the sea.

A Mountain

is a structure built so you can cross above the obstacle like river, valley or railway.

Woods

is a landform that rises at least 300 meters above the ground. It is higher than hills.

A Meadow



is a large area with little or no plants or trees.

A Waterfall

is an area of land that is covered with water.

A Lake

is a large hole inside the mountain or hill.



A Cliff

is a water that flows along the channel. It's a small narrow river.

A Jungle

is a land along the sea or lake.

A Plain



is a large area surrounded by land. It isn't connected to the sea.

A Bridge

is a field covered with grass and it usually has flowers in it.

A Swamp



is an area covered with trees, and it's smaller than forest.

A Desert

is an area of open land used for growing plants and keeping animals.

A Canyon



is a tropical forest where trees and plants grow very closely together.

A Cave

is a deep and narrow valley with many cliffs around.

A Field



is a place where water from a river or stream falls into a pool below.

A Shore

is a large area of flat land with no hills.
