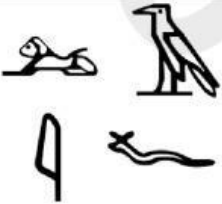
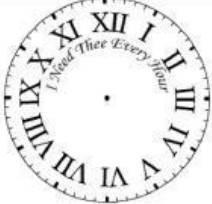
A. DEBATE TIPS

- **Confident speaking style:** When we debate, we are aiming to persuade others of our point of view. To do this, we need to be confident and persuasive in the way we speak.
 - **Speaking speed:** Try not to speak too slowly or too quickly. We need people to understand what we are saying.
 - **Volume:** We must try to speak at a volume that allows everyone to hear us.
 - **Tone:** Try to vary your tone to make it interesting. By speaking in a varying tone, listeners will be more interested in what we are saying.

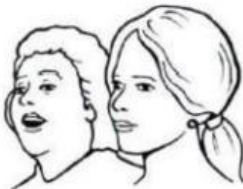

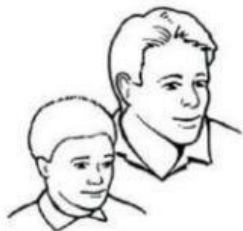
Sheila has decided to take her mother to the cinema for her birthday. They both like love stories that have happy endings.
