Scientists in Argentina found a special frog that can glow in moonlight and at twilight. This is unique because they know only a few insects and birds that do it.

When they used a special kind of light on the frogs, they were surprised to see a bright blue-green glow. The frogs even glowed in the dark when the scientists used a special black light. This helped the scientists find the frogs. They found this glowing ability in all the more than 100 polka-dot tree frogs they collected.

Finally, this discovery gave scientists a strong hint for the answer to an important question: is there a reason why some animals glow in the dark? The frog's moonlight glow suggests that there is.
