Dress Fish Fox	add -es (s', sh', ch', x')	Dresses Fishes Foxes

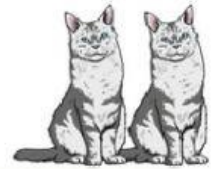
There is...
