Big Breakfast

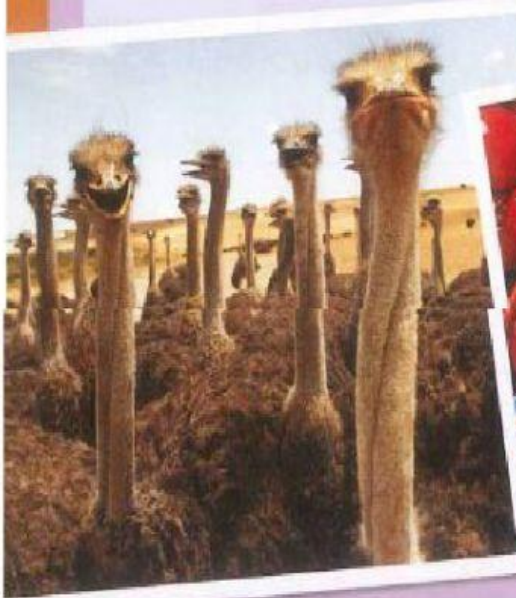
