Kate is not running. She is sitting. She is sitting on the bench.

Exercise 46

The teacher is not sitting. He is standing. He is standing at the table. He is speaking English. The teacher is wearing a shirt, a coat, trousers, a tie and shoes. His shirt is white, his coat is grey, his trousers are grey, too, his socks are black and his shoes are black.
