Hong Kong was a British colony since 1842. In 1997, after the Handover, Hong Kong became a part of China. Hong Kong is made up of 263 islands, and Lantau Island is the largest island in Hong Kong. Hong Kong Island is the second largest island. You can reach some of the smaller outlying islands by public ferry from Central Ferry Piers.

Hong Kong is famous for its skyscrapers, and, in fact, no other city has more of these than Hong Kong. As of June 2019, Hong Kong has 355 buildings higher than 150 metres. That is 77 more than its nearest rival New York. The tallest building in Hong Kong is the ICC (International Commerce Centre). The ICC is 484m high and has 118 floors, making it the 8th tallest building in the world.

Nearly 40% of Hong Kong is **designated** as Country Park. Although Hong Kong is famous for its skyscrapers, there is a huge amount of greenery. The Country Parks are home to hundreds of kilometres of hiking trails and picnic areas.

The Peak is Hong Kong's most visited tourist attraction. It provides guests with incredible views over the city from its elevated position 428 meters above sea level. The most popular way to get to the Peak is via the Peak Tram. The Peak Tram started operating in 1888 and remains one of the oldest and steepest funicular railways in the world.
