EXPRESSIONS OF GIVING OPINION

Ekspresi pendapat atau "expressions of opinion" adalah cara untuk menyampaikan pandangan, keyakinan, atau pendapat pribadi seseorang tentang suatu topik atau masalah. Ekspresi pendapat digunakan dalam berbagai konteks, baik dalam percakapan sehari-hari, diskusi kelompok, atau dalam penulisan formal.

Ekspresi pendapat dapat digunakan untuk menyampaikan preferensi, penilaian, atau evaluasi seseorang terhadap suatu hal.
