

## Yurts in Mongolia

Mongolia is in Central Asia. In Mongolia there is an area of flat grassland called the steppe. The steppe is a very dry place. The nomads live there.

Nomads keep animals such as horses, sheep, goats and camels. They move from place to place to look for grass for their animals to eat. This means they need houses that they can move. Their houses are called yurts. A yurt is a kind of round tent.

Yurts are usually about two metres high. They are made of wood. There is a cover around them. The cover is made of a material called felt. In their yurts, nomads cook on a stove. They put the stove in the middle of the yurt. A chimney at the top of the yurt takes the smoke away.

It is not only nomads who live in yurts. Near the capital Ulaanbaatar thousands of Mongolian people live in them.







## **FUN FACT**

Yurts are also called *gers*. The word 'ger' means 'home' in Mongolian.
