What are Mystery Texts?

A Mystery Text is a story or narrative in which something unexpected or unexplained happens, and the characters' work towards solving the mystery. Detective novels are the most common example of mystery texts, in which a detective follows clues to find out who committed a crime or murder. Famous literary detectives include Sherlock Holmes, Poirot and Inspector Morse.

Features of a Mystery Text: Building suspense, a variety of characters, metaphors, descriptions that utilise the five senses,etc.

The reader is usually left without all of the information regarding an event, finding out different bits of information along with the characters and the narrator. This helps to build the suspense as they read on to find out what happens.

Mystery texts are good for getting children engaged with books and literature, as they are encouraged to keep reading to reach the conclusion of the mystery. They are also a great way of exploring characterization, motives and behavior, and how this can be expressed in a text.
