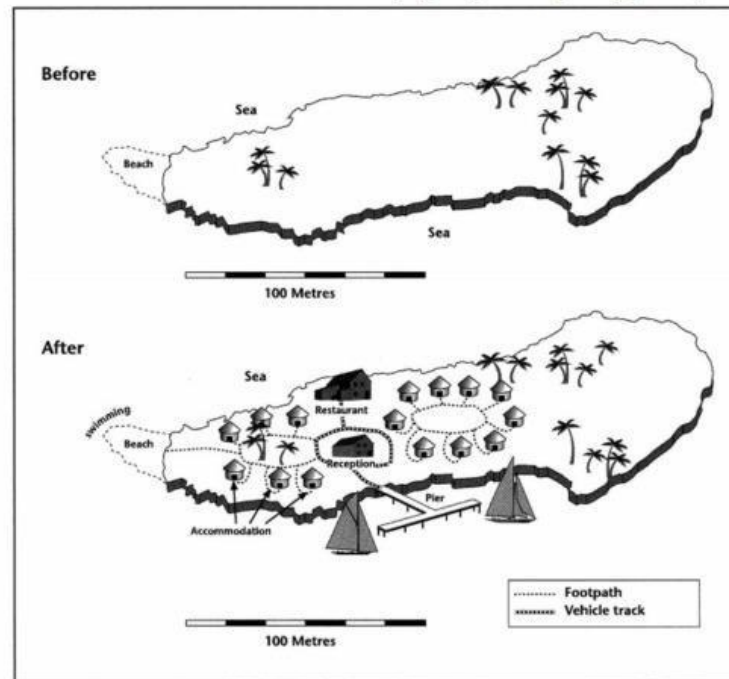


MAP SAMPLE

The two maps below show an island, before and after the construction of some tourist facilities.

Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features, and make comparisons where relevant.



The two maps illustrate **how/ when** a small island was **transform/ transformed** into an attractive tourist destination. In general, it can be noticed from the plans is that the island experienced **radical/ radically** changes with more tourist facilities.

Looking **at/ in** the maps in more detail, the first(*improve*) is that a pier was constructed with a view to **provide/ providing** access to the island. Next, the beach to the west of the island was **exploitation/ exploited** as a swimming area for tourists.
