MULTIPLICATION BY 10, 100 AND 1000

To multiply a number by 10, write a zero to the right of the number.

For example, $45 \times 10 = 450$; $16 \times 10 = 160$; $306 \times 10 = 3060$

Similarly, when you multiply a number by 100, write two zeros to the right of the number.

For example, $32 \times 100 = 3200$; $675 \times 100 = 67,500$; $560 \times 100 = 56,000$
