3. The total prize money for the winner and the runner up in the singles of 2014 Australian Open tennis tournament was 3,975,000 dollars. If the prize money for the runner - up was 1,325,000 dollars, then find out the prize money for the winner. dollars 
4. In 2011, there were 58,74,477,730 females as compared to 49,64,53,556 females in the year 2001. Find the increase in the female population from 2001 to 2011. females
Also, find out the increase in the male population from 2001 to 2011 if the number of males in these years were 53,21,56,772 and 62,31,21,843 respectively. males
