#### Present perfect (Thì hiện tại hoàn thành)

- Thì hiện tại hoàn thành dùng để diễn tả một hành động, sự việc đã bắt đầu từ trong quá khứ, kéo dài đến hiện tại và có thể tiếp tục xảy ra trong tương lai.

| <b>Positive</b> | S + have/has + V <sub>3/ed</sub> .                                             | Ex: She <b>has sent</b> letters to her friends.                                              |
| <b>Negative</b> | S + have/has + not + V <sub>3/ed</sub> .                                       | Ex: He <b>has not eaten</b> what she cooked.                                                 |
| <b>Question</b> | Have/Has + S + V <sub>3/ed</sub> ?<br>Wh- + have/has + S + V <sub>3/ed</sub> ? | Ex: <b>Have you eaten</b> lunch? - Yes, I have.<br>Where <b>have you been</b> since January? |

- Dấu hiệu nhận biết: **just = recently = lately, already, since, before, never, ever, yet, so far = until now = up to now = up to the present, for + khoảng thời gian, since + mốc thời gian cụ thể, the first/ second... time, etc.**

Ex: I **have not met** him **since** 2019.

She **hasn't told** me about you **yet**.

I **have never been** to Thailand.

\*Note: **have/has not = haven't/hasn't**
