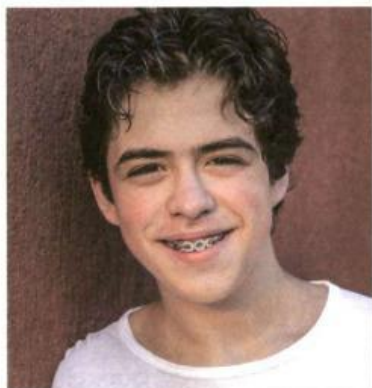

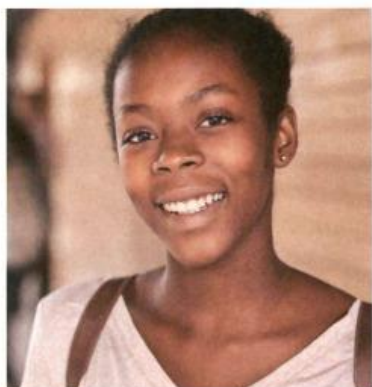

Sixto Diaz Rodriguez is an American folk singer from Detroit, Michigan, who only recently has become world famous. He is more than 70 years old now. He stopped dreaming and worked for years as a manual labourer.
