TENSES	FORMS	USES	EXAMPLES
The Simple Past	♦ BE: (+) S + was / were (-) S + wasn't / weren't (?) Was / Were + S? ♦ OTHER VERBS: (+) S + V-ed/ V 2 (+) S + didn't +V (?) Did + S+ V?	- a completed action in the past. - an action at a definite time in the past. Time expressions: yesterday, last week, (3 years) ago.	-She <u>was</u> at home yesterday. -They <u>weren't</u> at home last night. -<u>Were</u> you in Dalat 2 years ago? -We <u>went</u> to a concert yesterday. -It <u>didn't rain</u> yesterday morning. -What <u>did</u> she <u>do</u> last Sunday?
The Present Perfect	(+) S + have/has + V 3 (-) S+ haven't /hasn't + V3 (?) Have / Has + S + V 3	- an action beginning in the past and continuing up to the present. - an action at an indefinite time in the past Adverbs/ Prepositions of time: + ever/ never/ just / already → after "have" . + recently/ lately /yet /before → at the end of the sentence + since (1998) / for (5 years)	-She <u>has lived</u> here for 3 years. -Jane <u>hasn't phoned</u> me this week. -<u>Have</u> you <u>seen</u> her yet?

Present	S + wish + S + were S + wish + S + V-ed/V2	Unreal in the present	-He wishes he <u>were</u> at the seaside now. (He's at home now) -They wish they <u>had</u> a car. (They are poor and they can't buy a car.)
Future	S + wish + S + would + V	Unreal in the future	-She wishes she would come to the party tonight. (She will not come to the party tonight.)
