ADJECTIVE + **LY** = ADVERB
 QUIET (ADJ) → QUIET**LY** (ADV)



	RULES	EXAMPLES
ADJECTIVES	-an adjective tells us more about a noun. -We use adjectives before nouns and after a few verbs (especially BE)	Tom is a careful driver. Be quiet !
ADVERBS	-an adverbs tells us more about a verb. -an adverb tells us in what way someone does something or in what way something happens	Tom drove carefully along the narrow road. Speak quietly , please!

SOME ADVERBS HAVE THE SAME FORM AS THE ADJECTIVE:	
ADJECTIVE	ADVERB
He is a fast runner.	He runs fast .
She's a hard worker.	She works hard .
He's always late .	The train arrived late .
Chris is a fast driver.	Chris drives fast .
He caught the early train.	He always arrives early .
BUT: Tom is a good singer.	Tom sings well .
