A – Today is 13th September which is Roald Dahl Day. Roald Dahl is one of my favourite British short story writers. On this day, all over the world people remember the man and his work because it's his birthday.

B – He told his children his own stories at bedtime, and it was these stories that gave him the idea of writing books. When his children got bored listening to one of his stories, he changed it to make it more interesting in the book. Most of his ideas were from the people and the places around him.

C – He wrote nineteen children's books, as well as stories and articles for magazines such as *The New Yorker*. He also wrote television and film scripts. For example, he wrote *Chitty Chitty Bang Bang* and the film story for the James Bond film *You Only Live Twice*. His experience flying planes in the Second World War and his work as a spy with MI6 gave him the ideas for the James Bond film.

D – He even created a language called Gobblefunk. Oxford University Press made a dictionary called the *Roald Dahl Dictionary* and it has around 8,000 real and imaginary words from his books.

E – He wrote most of his books in a small building made of wood in his garden. He sat in an old armchair and wrote them on a writing board.
