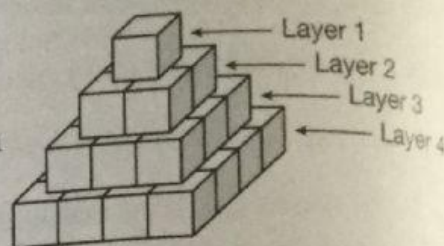


Try It

- ① At an amusement park, a building like this one will be made of huge blocks. It will light up 4 times each minute. How many blocks are needed to make 8 layers?

You can use the strategy *Look for a Pattern*.

Step 1 Look for a **pattern** in the number of blocks in each layer.

	1	2	3	4

The number of blocks in each layer is the layer number times itself.

Step 2 Extend the pattern.

How many blocks are in the eighth layer? _____

Step 3 Add the number of blocks in each layer.
