Prepositions before nouns (Giới từ đứng trước danh từ)

- Giới từ đứng trước danh từ chỉ giới từ được sử dụng để liên kết các danh từ và tính từ trong câu.

- Một số giới từ đứng trước danh từ phổ biến:

+ Giới từ chỉ địa điểm: **in, on, at, to, behind** (đằng sau), **under, next to, between** (ở giữa) ... **and** ..., etc.

Ex: He's **at** the train station.

The bakery is **between** my house **and** his house.

+ Giới từ chỉ tác nhân hay phương tiện: **with** (bằng), **by** (bằng, bởi), etc.

Ex: She cut the cake **with** a plastic knife.

+ Giới từ chỉ sự liên hệ hoặc đồng hành: **with**

Ex: I went to the concert **with** my brother.

+ Giới từ chỉ xu hướng của hành động: **into, from ... to ..., along, through, out of, across** (đi sang), etc.

Ex: The children jumped **into** the pool.

Just go **along** the street then you see the store at the corner.

Mary walked **through** the door.
