We use **Do** or **Does** to make questions.
Do I/You/We/They eat bread?
Does He/She/It eat bread?

The verb **doesn't change** in 3rd person singular.

Does she ~~eats~~ bread?
Does she eat bread? 

Answers
Yes, I **do**.
No, I **don't**.
Yes, **she does**.
No, **she doesn't**.
