The Present Perfect	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (+) S + have/has + V 3 (-) S+ haven't /hasn't + V3 (?) Have / Has + S + V 3 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ an action beginning in the past and continuing up to the present. ▪ an action at an indefinite time in the past ▪ Adverbs/ Prepositions of time: + ever/ never/ just / already → after "have". + recently/ lately /yet /before → at the end of the sentence + since (1998) / for (5 years) 	<p>-She <u>has lived</u> here for 3 years. -Jane <u>hasn't phoned</u> me this week. <u>Have</u> you <u>seen</u> her yet?</p>

Present	S + wish + S + were S + wish + S + V-ed/V2	Unreal in the present .	-He wishes he <u>were</u> at the seaside now. (He's at home now) -They wish they <u>had</u> a car. (They are poor and they can't buy a car.)
Future	S + wish + S + would + V	Unreal in the future	-She wishes she would come to the party tonight. (She will not come to the party tonight.)
