\_\_\_\_\_ - collects and highlights all the key features. This part contains comparatives and superlatives. It can't be too short.

\_\_\_\_\_ - contains information about the highest and the lowest key features.

\_\_\_\_\_ - contains the other features that don't show the significant difference.
