Fantastic Cities


This week we're looking at Melbourne, a wonderful city in Australia!

Fun for Kids

- **Funfields Theme Park**
One of Melbourne's most popular attractions. There are 22 rides, plus swimming pools and a barbecue area. Little children can have fun on mini go-karts, Ferris wheels and carousels made especially for them.
- **Collingwood Children's Farm**
Here you can milk the cows, feed the chicks, ride a pony and play with baby lambs.
- **SEA LIFE Melbourne**
The Aquarium has 12 themed zones with aquatic animals and plenty of educational and interactive exhibits for all ages. There's an interactive Rainforest Adventure, a Penguin Playground and a place to meet crocodiles.
- **Clip'n'Climb**
There are 33 different climbs here for beginners and experts. You can race your friends on the Speed Wall or use the challenge boards to climb each wall in a different way.
