Dividing Integers

An **Integer** is a whole number that may be either positive or negative.

To divide Integers with the same sign, Divide the two Integers and the quotient is always POSITIVE

Example:

$$(+20) \div (+4) = (+5)$$

$$(-20) \div (-4) = (+5)$$
