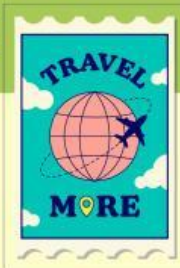



GERUND AND INFINITIVE




PUT THE VERB INTO EITHER THE GERUND (-ING) OR THE INFINITIVE WITH "TO"
