

Adverbs

An *adverb* tells you something about a verb. It answers the question *How?* It usually comes after the verb.

EXAMPLE: When we laugh, we breath quickly.
verb adverb

We usually form an adverb by adding **-ly** to an adjective.

EXAMPLES: loud → loudly; quiet → quietly
