Types of landforms

Continental Landforms

The continental landform is Earth's surface changes.

Desert: A dry area of land with few plants and little water.



Plain: A very large, flat area of grassy land.



Volcano: A mountain with an opening on the earth's crust that allows molten lava and gases to



Plateau: a large area of flat land that is higher than the land around it



Hill: a mound of raised land that is smaller than a mountain.



Valley: low area formed between mountains or hills.
